Festival RULES

- 1. Age is taken on the first day of the Dance Festival.
- 2. Birth Certificates may be requested for proof of age.
- 3. For Groups, age is determined by the oldest competitor.
- 4. Group dances must consist of 5 or more competitors.
- 5. Pointe Work should only be danced by Competitors in the age group Inters and above – any teams dancing Pointe Work in a lower age category will be disqualified.
- 6. No dancing out of section is allowed.
- 7. Strictly NO dancing or demonstrating to aid any competitor if they are unable to dance without prompts then please do not enter them.
- 8. The adjudicators decision is final.
- 9. Music will be played by the Organiser's team on CD, Ipad or Ipod only and must be handed in no later than two sections before the competitor is due to dance – please speak to us beforehand if you have any special requirements.
- **10**. All CD's should be clearly labelled with competitors Name, Section and Dance School name.
- 11. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- 12. Parent's will be responsible for their own children and children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 13. No responsibility will be taken for any loss of goods or personal possessions -- please make sure that your items are clearly labelled and not left unattended.
- 14. If you need to withdraw from the festival, a minimum of 8 weeks notice is required in order for you to receive a full refund -- anything after this will incur a 25% charge.
- 15. All payments made for any Personalised Items ordered will be NON Refundable.
- **16**. Groups have a time limit of 5 minutes with an extra 30 seconds allowed for Cabaret sections.

- 17. Absolutely no Dance Teachers, Chaperones or Parents are allowed back stage only licensed members of the Festival Team are permitted backstage due to licensing regulations, therefore children must be left at the stage door and passed over to a member of our Licensed Chaperone Team for each section that they are entered in.
- 18. Please be considerate of the venue and the festival staff and clean up anything left behind in the dressing rooms and theatre.
- 19. No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
- 20. Circumstances beyond the control of LaVolta Events Ltd. such as: weather related issues, facility condition, and technical difficulties bears no responsibility to LaVolta Events and no refunds will be given in these circumstances.
- 21. Studios will be notified of the schedule approximately three weeks prior to the festival.
- 22. No changes will be permitted once the final schedule has been sent out.
